The following rules and regulations are solely applicable to the Adrenaline Motorplex Mud Race Series events. This Rulebook is intended as a guide for the conduct of the Adrenaline Racing Series and is in no way a guarantee against injury or death to participants, spectators, or employees.

By submitting an entry and/or participating in any activity related to an Adrenaline Motorplex event, a participant agrees to the following:

- 1. All rules set forth in the Adrenaline Motorplex rules and its amendments are applicable and will be followed.
- 2. All decisions of Adrenaline Motorplex officials are final, non-appealable, and non-litigable.
- 3. All participants voluntarily assume the risk of damage to the race vehicle, the driver, pit crew, or any other person and have no claim for said damages against Adrenaline Motorplex, Five H Farms, track owners, officials, agents, or employees of Adrenaline Motorplex.
- 4. Neither Adrenaline Motorplex, Five H Farms, nor the facility owner will be responsible for the adequacy of a participant's race vehicle, equipment, or racing activity.
- 5.All participants assume full responsibility for any and all injuries sustained, including death and property damage, anytime they are in the racing areas or to or from the racing areas.
- 6. All participants understand the risk of serious injury or death, which may result from racing, and that participants solely assume that risk when choosing to participate in an Adrenaline Motorplex event. No entrant, pit crew member, family member or vehicle sponsor shall have any claim for damages, expenses, lawsuits or otherwise against Adrenaline Motorplex, Five H Farms, the owners, staff, promoters, track builders, race operators, Adrenaline Motorplex officers, agents or directors arising from damage to any vehicle, personal injury or death, or monetary loss of any kind whatsoever. All entrants, family members, pit crew members or vehicle sponsors who voluntarily participate in any racing activities conducted under these rules, waive any claim they may have against Adrenaline Motorplex, Five H Farms, the owners, promoters, track builders, race operators, Adrenaline Motorplex officials, agents, vendors, employees, volunteers, or directors.
- 7. Any person who performs an act or participates in actions deemed by Adrenaline Motorplex as detrimental to the Mud Racing Series or to Adrenaline Motorpex's facility: a disqualification and/or loss of series points, and/or loss of finishing position(s) in the event, and/or suspension may be imposed. This includes postings/commenting on all social media platforms 8. Adrenaline Motorplex assumes no responsibility whatsoever for delays, postponements or cancellations of all or part of an event for any reason, including inclement weather, acts of God, or unsafe course conditions.

- 9. Adrenaline Motorplex & Its series reserves the right to refuse entry to any applicant, team, competitor, entrant, participant, or any other person, to any event for any reason.
- 10. No participant may enter the racing areas (to include the pit area) unless he/she has personally signed all required entry forms, waivers, release of liability forms to the event
- 11. Each participant, by entering an Adrenaline Motorplex event, grants to authorized agents the rights to all photography & videography for promotional use.

THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE A GUIDE FOR CONDUCT AT THE FACILITY AND IN NO WAY ARE A GUARANTEE AGAINST INJURY OR DEATH TO PARTICIPANTS, PIT CREWS, SPONSORS, OFFICIALS, SPECTATORS OR EMPLOYEES. The following rules may be amended at any time. If you are reading these live they are fully up to date. Racing officials' interpretation and or clarification will prevail upon disagreement or dispute the meaning of these rules.

All COMPETITORS, PARTICIPANTS, PARTICIPANTS FAMILY MEMBERS, PIT CREWS, OWNERS, SPONSORS & OFFICIALS AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

Determinations by Officials as to the application & interpretation of the rules are NON-LIGITABLE, covenant and will not initiate or maintain litigation of any kind against Adrenaline Motorplex, Five H Farms, staff, its owners, sponsors, staff officials, directors, volunteers or anyone acting on its behalf with respect to such determinations. In the event a participant violates that covenant and initiates litigation, it is agreed that the participant will reimburse Adrenaline Motorplex & Five H Farms for all costs associated, rights to a trial will be waived and Adrenaline Motorplex & Five H Farms reserves the right to take action for the violation of this covenant not to sue.

By submitting an entry form and or participating in ANY ACTIVITY related to an Adrenaline Motorplex event or Five H Farms or the owners, the participant agrees to the following:

- 1. All rules are applicable and will be followed
- 2. All participants voluntarily assume all of the risk of damage to the race vehicle, the driver/participant/pit crews or any other persons to have no claim for said damages against Adrenaline Motorplex, Five H Farms, track owners, promoters, officials, agents, or employees or anyone acting on behalf of Adrenaline Motorplex.
- 3. All participants are responsible for the adequacy of their race vehicle, equipment and racing activity
- 4. All participants assume the full responsibility for ANY & ALL injuries sustained, including death and property damage any time they are in the racing areas or to and from the racing areas or on the facility grounds
- 5. All participants fully understand the risk of serious injury or death, which may result from racing, and participants solely assume that risk when choosing to participate in the event. No entrant, pit crew, family member or sponsor shall have claim for damages, expenses, lawsuits or otherwise against Adrenaline Motorplex Series, Five H Farms, the owners, promoters, track builders, race operators, officials, agents or directors that may arise from any damage to any vehicle, personal injury or death, or monetary loss of any kind whatsoever. You will be waiving any claim they may have against Adrenaline Motorplex, Five H Farms, the owners, promotors, staff, track builders, racing officials, vendors, agents, volunteers, operators or directors.

- 6. All participants authorize the use of all images, videos to include his/herself, family members, sponsors, pit crew etc for the reason of promotion of Adrenaline Motorplex's facility
- 7. NO participant or part of their team is allowed to act unprofessionally against or towards any racing official at any time during the event.
- 8. ALL RACERS REGARDLESS OF AGE (MINORS MUST HAVE PARENTS FILL OUT) MUST SIGN THE RACING WAIVER, ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RULES AND COMPLETE A SIGNED W 9 PRIOR TO ANY ACTIVITY AT ANY ADRENALINE MOTORPLEX EVENT.
- 9. REFUND POLICY-ALL REFUNDS MUST BE REQUESTED THROUGH THE REGISTRAR. ONCE A VEHICLE ENTERS THE RACE COURSE, WHETHER IT BE FOR PRACTICE OR COMPETITION, A REFUND CAN NO LONGER BE ISSUED.
- 10. Every racer/participant must check in at the registration area to register. If this is not done, they will be moved to the back of the 1st race lineup.
- 11. ALL racers must be present at the drivers meeting. If not a member of their pit crew must be present. Failure to attend could result in penalties.

ALL Competitors must register for the race before operating their machine anywhere on the facility OR risk penalties

ALL GENERAL AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET IN ORDER TO RUN.

ALL DISCREPANCIES GO TO THE OFFICIALS AND THEIR DECISIONS ARE FINAL. ALL GENERAL RULES WILL APPLY. PLEASE READ AND KNOW THE RULES FOR YOUR CLASS AND ALSO THE GENERAL RULES. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OPERATION OF YOUR VEHICLE AT ALL TIMES.

General Rules-NO REFUNDS AFTER REGISTRATION

** ADRENALINE MOTORPLEX NOR ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES OR OWNERS PROVIDE INSURANCE TO OUR RACERS- THAT IS THE RESPONSBILITY OF THE RACER.

**ALL RACERS MUST HAVE A RACE # SOMEWHERE VISIBLE ON THE PASSENGER SIDE OF THEIR RACE VEHICLE LEGIBLE AT ALL TIMES FOR THE SCORER TO SEE. THIS WILL BE A NUMBER CHOSEN BY THE RACER AND WILL BE THE SAME # ALL YEAR LONG. CHANGES IN RACE # WILL BE DONE AT REGISTRATION TO ALLOW POINTS TO REMAIN INTACT & CORRECT.

** IF A SINGLE RACER ENTERS A CLASS MORE THAN 1 TIME THEY CAN ONLY PLACE 1 TIME IN THAT CLASS

** IF A SINGLE TRUCK RUNS MORE THAN 1 TIME IN ANY CLASS EVEN IF THERE ARE DIFFERENT DRIVERS, ONLY 1 OF THE DRIVERS CAN PLACE IN THAT CLASS

**IF A VEHICLE GOES LESS THAN 20' IN THE PIT, THE CREW WILL TAKE A MEASUREMENT FROM THE CENTER OF THE FRONT HUB. IF IT IS LESS THAN 20', DRIVER IS ENTITLED TO A RE-RUN

- 1. When a driver is exiting & at the end of the pit, they MUST COME TO A COMPLETE STOP at the designated stopping area so the officials know that the driver is under complete control. If a driver fails to stop at the designated area required by officials after leaving the pit, they will be automatically DIS QUALIFIED AND NO REFUND GIVEN- NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 2. If a driver exits the pit at any time during their run, whichever tire leaves the pit, the measurement will be from that exit point not a timed run.
- 3. All racers/drivers must sign the necessary waivers
- 4. All drivers and passengers must wear & have all required safety gear
- 5. All vehicles must pass all safety inspections prior to racing
- 6. General registration will end 30 minutes prior to the scheduled race and all late entries must run first in their class with NO RE-RUN OPTION..
- 7. Payback is 100% of entry fees-(1st place-50%. 2nd place-30%, 3rd place-20%)
- 8. In the event of a tie, the drivers will split the money for that place
- 9. AMP officials may refuse any driver who appears intoxicated and/or any vehicle that is operating in an unsafe manner
- 10. The red flagman will be the head official of the trackside
- 11. Vehicles need to be staged at least 5 minutes prior to running after the pit has been cleared
- 12. Time starts when you cross the start beam
- 13. When forward motion stops, you will be red flagged to shut down
- 14. No alcoholic beverages are allowed at trackside
- 15. Follow all rules by staff
- 16. Mud trucks in designated areas only
- 17. In all classes- if you are the first one to go through the pit, you have the option for a rerun. Must tell track officials before leaving the end of the track, if not told you will be stuck with that time and run
- 18. <u>DRINKING OR DRUG USAGE BEFORE RACING IS NOT ALLOWED & WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.</u> AN AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION WILL BE ENFORCED.
- 19. You are responsible for the safe operation of your vehicle at all times
- 20. Fire suit is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED & REQUIRED if running nitrous or alcohol
- 21. KEEP IT SAFE & HAVE FUN!!

BOG PIT CLASSES-

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CLASSES

YOUTH STOCK CLASS- (KIDS AGE 9-17) (UNDER AGE 16 MUST HAVE AN ADULT PASSENGER)

This class is intended for youth beginners. It is a stock vehicle class..This is a low HP class(400 HP & Under). A legal guardian must ride along for the race. Vehicles, drivers & passengers must meet all safety requirements for this class. All safety gear is required for this class for both passengers. Race seat & 5 point harness is required in all classes unless otherwise specified

CLASS SAFETY REQUIRMENTS

- 1. Helmet
- 2. Seatbelt
- 3. Legal Guardian passenger
- 4. Must pass tech & safety inspection
- 5. Fire Extinguisher mounted and in reach of the driver
- 6. Fire suit is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for all drivers
- 7. Trophy 1-3rd place

Race seat & 5 point harness is required in all classes unless otherwise specified
** MUST HAVE A PULL OUT POINT AT REAR AND FRONT OF VEHICLE
PREFERABLY A CLEVIS ON THE BUMPER OR A FRAME RAIL FIRMLY ATTACHED
AND LONG ENOUGH TO SLIDE A 6 INCH HOOK THROUGH. A PIECE OF
CHAIN/ROPE ETC IS NOT ALLOWED**.

STOCK FARMTRUCK-(AGE 9 & UP) (UNDER AGE 16 MUST HAVE AN ADULT PASSENGER)

This class is intended for vehicles that have NOT BEEN modified for competition AND carry a stock appearance and are still legally capable of being driven on the street. This is an all motor, stock suspension, UN-MODIFIED class.

** MUST HAVE A PULL OUT POINT AT REAR AND FRONT OF VEHICLE PREFERABLY A CLEVIS ON THE BUMPER OR A FRAME RAIL FIRMLY ATTACHED AND LONG ENOUGH TO SLIDE A 6 INCH HOOK THROUGH. A PIECE OF CHAIN/ROPE ETC IS NOT ALLOWED**.

CLASS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS-NO EXCEPTIONS-

- 1. Helmet
- 2. Seat Belt- 5 Point harness is HIGHLY recommended
- 3. Fire extinguisher mounted in reach of the driver
- 4. Fire suit is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for all drivers

BODY & FRAME MODS-

- No gutting or skinning of any body parts unless for tire clearance-(Must retain dash, no skinned doors, must retain original firewall and floor pan. MINIMAL REMOVAL ALLOWED TO FIT ROLL CAGES INSIDE CAB-PER T4ECH APPROVAL)
- 2. Firewalls must be stock, no relocating, no moving and no reshaping
- 3. Must be factory glass-(Lexan and plexiglass are not allowed)
- 4. Front bumper REQUIRED/all lights and glass must be present
- 5. No body swaps
- 6. No frame modifications of any kid
- 7. No fiberglass bodies
- 8. Must have a factory full bed or fully functional flatbed that meets tech approval. No barn tin or plastic flatbeds

SUSPENSION-

- 1. Stock suspension with a 3 leaf minimum, I If your vehicle was factory equipped with coil springs from the factory they're allowed in an UN-MODIFIED setting.
- 2. Lift kits are NOT ALLOWED
- 3. No leaf springs, sliders, bird cages, floaters or coilovers
- 4. No 3 link suspensions
- 5. No 4 link suspensions

BRAKES-

- 1. Brakes must have all 4 brakes on each corner and must function properly
- 2. No wheel base alterations

ENGINE & TRANSMISSION MODS- NONE

ALL GENERAL AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET IN ORDER TO RUN. ALL DISCREPANCIES GO TO THE OFFICIALS AND THEIR DECISIONS ARE FINAL. ALL GENERAL RULES WILL APPLY. PLEASE READ AND KNOW THE RULES FOR YOUR CLASS AND ALSO THE GENERAL RULES. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OPERATION OF YOUR VEHICLE AT ALL TIMES.

36" STOCK-(AGE 14 & UP) (UNDER AGE 16 MUST HAVE AN ADULT PASSENGER)

This class is intended for vehicles that have been slightly modified for competition but still carry a stock appearance but are still legally capable of being driven on the street. This is an all motor, stock suspension, UN-MODIFIED 36" DOT tire class. Race seat & 5 point harness is required in all classes unless otherwise specified

** MUST HAVE A PULL OUT POINT AT REAR AND FRONT OF VEHICLE PREFERABLY A CLEVIS ON THE BUMPER OR A FRAME RAIL FIRMLY ATTACHED AND LONG ENOUGH TO SLIDE A 6 INCH HOOK THROUGH. A PIECE OF CHAIN/ROPE ETC IS NOT ALLOWED**.

CLASS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS-NO EXCEPTIONS-

- 5. Helmet
- 6. Seat Belt- 5 Point harness is HIGHLY recommended
- 7. 6 point roll cage is HIGHLY recommended tied to the frame
- 8. IF RUNNING A RACE SEAT AND HARNESS THEN A ROLL CAGE IS MANDATORY
- 9. Fire extinguisher mounted in reach of the driver
- 10. Fire suit is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for all drivers

BODY & FRAME MODS-

- No gutting or skinning of any body parts unless for tire clearance-(Must retain dash, no skinned doors, must retain original firewall and floor pan. MINIMAL REMOVAL ALLOWED TO FIT ROLL CAGES INSIDE CAB-PER T4ECH APPROVAL)
- 10. Firewalls must be stock, no relocating, no moving and no reshaping
- 11. Must be factory glass-(Lexan and plexiglass are not allowed)
- 12. Front bumper REQUIRED/all lights and glass must be present
- 13. No body swaps
- 14. No frame modifications of any kid
- 15. No fiberglass bodies
- 16. Must have a factory full bed or fully functional flatbed tht meets tech approval. No barn tin or plastic flatbeds

SUSPENSION-

- 6. Stock suspension with a 3 leaf minimum, I If your vehicle was factory equipped with coil springs from the factory they're allowed in an UN-MODIFIED setting.
- 7. Lift kits are allowed
- 8. No leaf springs, sliders, bird cages, floaters or coilovers
- 9. No 3 link suspensions
- 10. No 4 link suspensions

BRAKES-

- 3. Brakes must have all 4 brakes on each corner and must function properly
- 4. No wheel base alterations

ENGINE & TRANSMISSION MODS-

- 1. Engine must be in the stock location
- 2. No engine swaps -(Ford-Ford or Chevy-Chevy)
- 3. No radiator/battery relocate must be in factory location
- 4. No aluminum heads or blocks unless OEM in the OEM vehicle/model/year
- 5. No aftermarket head of any kind OEM heads ONLY
- 6. Single carb only-(No dual carbs, SV or dominators
- 7. Carburetor spacers are allowed
- 8. No trans-brakes
- 9. Noi fuel injection unless factory equipped
- 10. No Nitrous, blowers, superchargers or forced induction of any kind
- 11. Aftermarket ignition components will be allowed -(I.E-msd boxes, distributor etc)
- 12. No vacuum pumps
- 13. Fuel must be pump gas-No race fuel or alcohol
- 14. Fuel cells are allowed
- 15. Mechanical fuel pumps or electric fuel pumps are allowed
- 16. Full exhaust must be present with mufflers
- 17. Headers are allowed-(Pipes must extend past driver compartment
- 18. Stock OEM transmissions and transfers cases -(no aftermarket transfer cases or transmissions are allowed)

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38.5" HOT STOCK-(14 & UP-)

(UNDER AGE 16 MUST HAVE ADULT PASSENGER) This class is intended for vehicles that have been slightly modified for competition but still carry a stock appearance. This class is an all motor, stock suspension, 38.5" UN-MODIFIED DOT tire class. Race seat & 5 point harness is required in all classes unless otherwise specified ** MUST HAVE A PULL OUT POINT AT REAR AND FRONT OF VEHICLE PREFERABLY A CLEVIS ON THE BUMPER OR A FRAME RAIL FIRMLY ATTACHED AND LONG ENOUGH TO SLIDE A 6 INCH HOOK THROUGH. A PIECE OF CHAIN/ROPE ETC IS NOT ALLOWED**.

CLASS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS-NO EXCEPTIONS-

- 1. Seat belt-5 point harness is HIGHLY recommended
- 2. Roll cage tied to frame HIGHLY recommended
- U joint shields,transmission shields and driveshaft loops ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED
- 4. Fire suit is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for all drivers
- 5. Fire extinguisher mounted and in reach of the driver

BODY & FRAME MODS-

- 1. Bed gutting is allowed but must retain stock resemblance of what bed came with the vehicle-(cab interior parts can be removed, plastic/carpet/dash etc)
- 2. Front Bumpers are HIGHLY RECOMMENDED
- 3. Must have all windows in tact
- No frame modification of any kind-(only modification acceptable is cutting down
 of frame for example long bed to fit short bed-no reshaping, forming of frames
 allowed.
- 5. No driver relocating-(must sit in factory location)
- 6. No fiberglass bodies
- 7. Firewall must be stock, no relocating, reshaping or moving
- 8. Radiator must be in stock location
- 9. Brakes(whatever present) must be able to stop vehicle NO EXCEPTIONS

SUSPENSION-

- 1. No coilovers, floaters, sliders, or birdcages
- 2 Leaf Spring minimum at all four corners-OEM coil spring is allowed in front if so equipped from factory (example-Ford front colis-UN-MODIFIED and no aftermarket components)
- 3. No altering of the wheel bae
- 4. No 3 links
- 5. No 4 links
- 6. Lift kits and ladder bars will be allowed

ENGINE & TRANSMISSION MODS-

- 1. No engine swaps- (example- Ford to Ford or Chevy to Chevy)
- 2. S-10's, rangers & dakotas can only run small blocks- (Chevy to Chevy, Jeep to Jeep, Ford to Ford and Dodge to Dodge)
- 3. No aluminum heads or blocks unless OEM in OEM vehicle for make/model/year
- 4. Dual carbs not allowed
- 5. No sheet metal intakes
- 6. No fuel injection unless factory equipped
- 7. No relocating the engine. Engine must be in the factory location with OEM firewall in tact
- 8. No Nitrous, blowers, superchargers or ford induction of any kind
- 9. Open headers are allowed-UP, DOWN OR BACKSWEPT BUT MUST NOT BE FACED TOWARD THE CROWD IN ANY WAY!! NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 10. Race fuel are allowed-(fuel cells are allowed and may use mechanical or electrical fuel pumps
- 11. Stock transfer cases only-(no chain drives
- 12. Aftermarket transmissions are allowed/stall convertors/trans brakes allowed
- 13. Transmission shield or blankets are HIGHLY RECOMMENDED

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40" SUPER STOCK-(16 & UP)

This is an all motor, stock style leaf spring suspension class. Engine and body swaps are allowed. Vehicle will not need to be street capable, but still carry a stock appearance. This class will be run with a 40" maximum tire size that is DOT legal and UN-MODIFIED. Race seat & 5 point harness is required in all classes unless otherwise specified

** MUST HAVE A PULL OUT POINT AT REAR AND FRONT OF VEHICLE PREFERABLY A CLEVIS ON THE BUMPER OR A FRAME RAIL FIRMLY ATTACHED AND LONG ENOUGH TO SLIDE A 6 INCH HOOK THROUGH. A PIECE OF CHAIN/ROPE ETC IS NOT ALLOWED**.

CLASS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS-NO EXCEPTIONS

- 1. Helmet
- 2. 5 Point harness
- 3. Minimum Of 6 point roll cage
- 4. Drive shaft loops and U joint shields
- 5. Fire suit
- 6. Safety nets are REQUIRED if no side windows/doors on vehicle
- 7. Fire extinguisher mounted and in reach of the driver

BODY & FRAME MODS-

- 1. Must be an OEM cab
- 2. No narrowing of the cab
- 3. No driver relocating (NO CENTER SEAT)
- 4. Must have front clip/fenders (can be fiberglass replacement)
- 5. Frame must be OEM (modifications allowed to strengthen and for safety-(no back halves or round tubing-materials used must match the dimensions of the OEM frame being used and will be at Techs discretion)
- 6. Tires must be in the wheel/fender well location of the body being used.

SUSPENSION-

- 1. Coilovers are allowed as long as leaf springs are present and functional!!
- 2. No 3 link suspensions
- 3. No 4 link suspensions
- 4. Minimum of 2 leaf springs at all 4 corners attached to axle and frame and functional

BRAKES-

1. Brakes must be in working order and on both axles (driveline brakes are acceptable but 4 wheel brakes are HIGHLY RECOMMENDED)

ENGINE & TRANSMISSION MODS-

- 1. Aluminum head are allowed
- 2. No aluminum blocks are allowed (NO exotic, spread port, canted valve, pro-stock style heads on a BIG BLOCK engine)
- 3. No aftermarket injection
- 4. No sheet metal intakes
- 5. No dual carbs
- 6. Harmonic balancer must be within 6 inches of front axle tube
- 7. No aftermarket f-case/chain drives???
- 8. No Nitrous, blowers, superchargers, or forced induction of any kind
- 9. Open exhaust is allowed (MUST NOT BE AIMED AT THE CROWD) Race fuel and Alcohol is allowed-must be in a fuel cell (fire suit is REQUIRED)
- Aftermarket or stock transmission is allowed (SHIELDS OR BLANKET IS REQUIRED)
- 11. Must have a firewall- it can be OEM or made of aluminum, but must shield the driver from the engine and be of substantial materials.

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OPEN CLASS- (AGE 18 & UP)

This class is intended for highly modified 4 wheel drive vehicles featuring full tube(rail) chassis vehicles. This class is primarily a supercharged alcohol injected class which also allows turbochargers, nitrous, as well as naturally aspirated combinations. Any engine location and aluminum engine blocks are permitted. These vehicles need not resemble any factory produced vehicle. Vehicles must meet all safety requirements for this class **Race seat & 5 point** harness is required in all classes unless otherwise specified

CLASS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Helmet
- 2. 6 point roll cage
- 3. Fire suit
- 4. U joint shields
- 5. Driveshaft loops
- 6. 5 point harness
- 7. Fire extinguishers are mounted and in reach of the driver

BODY-(OPEN PIT)

- 1. A body is required . it should be constructed from metal, fiberglass, or plastic and can be any design. It should cover the drivers compartment of the vehicle.
- 2. A firewall and floor pan shall be present protecting the driver from engine and driveline components. Minimum 0.030 steel ot 0.060 aluminum recommended.

CHASSIS-(OPEN PIT)

1. Chassis material shall meet tech's minimum requirements. However these are minimum standards and do not imply nor guarantee a drivers or vehicles safety.

ADDITIONAL CHASSIS GUIDELINES-

- 1. All rear engine vehicles require that the roll cage must extend forward of the drivers feet in order to provide adequate protection for the drivers compartment.
- 2. Any engine locations is allowed
- 3. Any type of suspension is allowed.
- 4. Any type of transmission is allowed.

- 6. Any OEM style front and rear differentials are allowed. Modifications are allowed

ENGINE-(OPEN PIT)

- 1. Any Automotive type engine, cast iron or aluminum block is allowed
- 2. Any automotive type cylinder head is allowed
- 3. Power Adders: Superchargers, turbochargers and Nitrous are allowed
- 4. Any intake is allowed
- 5. Multiple carburetors are allowed
- 6. Any aftermarket fuel injection is allowed
- 7. Any type of fuel is allowed-must be in fuel cell-Race fuel is allowed-M-1, M-3, M-5 Alcohols are allowed
- 8. No Nitro methane or similar fuel accelerators.
- 9. Competition exhaust is allowed

MUST HAVE A PULL OUT POINT AT REAR AND FRONT OF VEHICLE, PREFERABLY A CLEVIS ON THE BUMPER OR FRAME RAIL, FIRMLY ATTACHED AND LONG ENOUGH TO SLIDE A 6 INCH HOOK THROUGH. A PIECE OF CHAIN/ROPE ETC IS NOT ALLOWED.

CLASS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Helmet
- 2. 6 point roll cage
- 3. 5 point harness
- 4. Fire suit is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED & REQUIRED if running nitrous or alcohol
- 5. Fire extinguisher mounted and in reach of the driver

ENGINE-

- 3. Must have a firewall between the engine and the driver.

TRANSFER CASE-

- 1. Any stock or aftermarket transfer case setup chain drive is allowed
- 2. Chain drives require shields

SUSPENSION-

- 1. Any suspension is allowed
- 2. Tech approval for safety

CHASSIS-

- 1. Any stock or competition tube chassis is allowed
- 2. Tech approval for safety

TIRES-

- 1. Any tractor tire is allowed
- 2. Any size tractor tire is allowed
- 3. Tractor Tires on all 4 corners or 2 UNCUT DOT on fronts & 2 tractors on rear
- 4. NO paddle tires are allowed
- 5. Tires may be modified/grooved
- 6. NO CUT DOT tires allowed

AXLES-

- 1. Any axle combination is allowed
- Aftermarket axles are allowed.

BODY-

1. Must have body or panels around driver compartment

ROLL CAGE-

- 1. Must be 6 points tied to frame and of safe construction
- 2. SUBJECT TO TECH APPROVAL

BRAKES-

- 1. Must have 4 wheel brakes or drive line bakes or a combination of both
- 2. Brakes must work/lock tires

- 5. Any aftermarket/stock transfer case is allowed (chain drives are allowed)
